



## **Bubbles**

## Introduction

Bubbles are fun to play with and can also teach many elementary science concepts. There are four components to this activity: *Frozen Bubbles, Shape Bubbles, Coloured Bubble Art* and *Bouncing Bubbles*. Each of these activities can be done individually or as part of a bubble-themed lesson plan.

Frozen Bubbles provides an opportunity to view the transformation from a liquid to a solid. Shape Bubbles serves as an introduction to geometric shapes, such as spheres, cubes and pyramids. Coloured Bubble Art can be integrated into an art lesson, where students can create their own bubble art. In Bouncing Bubbles glycerin is added to the bubble mixture, which allows students to touch and play with the bubbles without popping them.
