



Shopping List

Quantities listed assume that the activity will be performed once. The listed initial cost assumes that the activity has never been performed before and that all of the materials must be purchased. The legend below provides details of where the materials can be found:

It is best to use the darkest chocolate possible (highest cocoa percentage), since the higher cocoa butter content and lower milk ingredients allows the chocolate to melt more precisely. Large chocolate bars (29 cm) are ideal but several smaller chocolate bars can be grouped together to achieve the same effect. The amount of chocolate needed varies depending on the size of the microwave. Buy at least twice the amount of chocolate in case of unforseen circumstances such as breaking or accidental eating.
