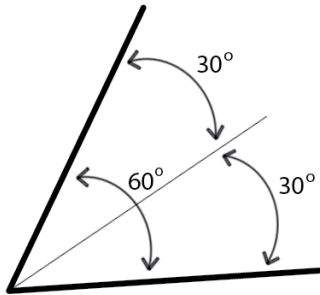
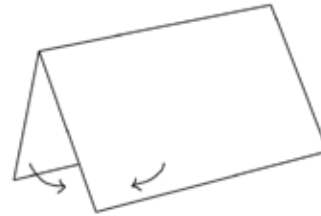


Glossary

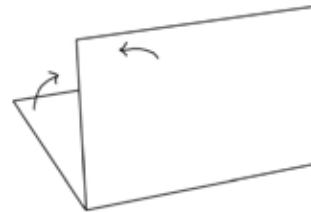
angle bisector - a line that divides an angle into two equal angles. The line is equidistant (the same distance) from the sides of the original angle.



mountain fold - a fold made by folding a paper sheet away from you, creating a peaked crease which resembles a mountain.



valley fold - a fold that results from folding a paper sheet towards you, creating a crease at the bottom of the sheet which resembles a valley.



congruence - two figures are congruent if they have the same shape and size.

midline (line of symmetry) - a line that divides a figure in half such that the two halves are mirror images of each other.
