## **Class Organization**

For Real Flowers, ask the students to sit in a manner that offers a clear view of the flower.

For Filter Flowers, students can create individual flowers.

### Notes

There are two activities in this blueprint, *Real Flowers* and *Filter Flowers*. They can either be done separately or together.

#### **Further Exploration**

This activity provides a good gateway to discussions about the different parts of a plant, plant reproduction and the elements needed for plant survival, such as water, nutrients and light. One way to demonstrate these principles is to grow a small garden or some potted plants with the class.
