



## Time / Cost Estimate

### Time:

To simplify planning, the time required for each section is listed separately.

### Real Flowers: Active - 10 min / Wait - 24 hr

The active time for this section is very short, but can vary somewhat depending on the number of flowers being dyed.

### Filter Flowers: Prep - 10 min / Wait - 48 hr / Active 45 min

The preparation time mainly entails the time needed to cut the pieces of string and, as such, depends on the number of filter flowers that will be dyed. The active time is an estimate of the time it will take for each student in a class of 30 to make one flower. The waiting time takes into account the time needed to dye the flowers as well as the drying time.

### Initial Cost: \$28.00

For *Real Flowers*, the cost depends on the type and the quantity of flowers bought. Roses are expensive, but will produce the most impressive final result. Other white flowers are fairly cheap and can be purchased at your local florist. Alternatively, suitable flowers can be picked outdoors at no cost.

Concerning *Filter Flowers*, costs can be reduced by bringing plastic containers and baskets from home. Many of the consumable items can be used more than once before they will need to be replaced. It is important to note that the amount of materials needed will depend on the number of filter flowers being made.
